Established in 1948, we are Australia's premier shooting organisation representing more than 180,000 members interested in shooting sports, hunting and wildlife management.


We have official Non-Government Organisation status with the United Nations and we regularly participate in international discussions.

# SSAA Farmer Assist

The Sporting Shooters' Association of Australia (SSAA) has launched its 'SSAA Farmer Assist' program throughout Australia. This program has been developed to provide farmers and landholders with a simple way of finding qualified SSAA members to undertake shooting as part of pest control activities. This service is provided at no cost.

The program has a unique online portal that acts like an introductory service. Farmers and landholders simply register and then use the program's job board to seek assistance to deal with problem wildlife on their properties. Once the request has been added to the jobs board, only registered members approved for the program can respond to the request. Farmers then simply choose which member/s they want to contact after viewing submitted applications.

For extra peace of mind, all SSAA members participating in the SSAA Farmer Assist Program are covered by the Association's \$20m public liability insurance policy. Members involved in the program have committed to a strict code of practice that incorporates safety, animal welfare and ethical shooting.

Members must undertake an assessment to display a professional-like shooting standard.

## Farmer Registration Process

Four simple steps to receiving free pest control.

- 1 Sign-up via online portal
- 2 Place a request (job) for assistance
- 3 Receive and then review applications
- 4 Select member/s of your choice
